Why should I choose Torrens University over another provider?

Will I have to pay additional fees if I enrol at Torrens University?

We are pleased to announce that we will be offering all students transferring from HETC a scholarship to ensure that your current fees are matched.

(Please note our fees do increase year on year by a maximum of 10%).

What courses can I study?

We will be offering the following courses to HETC students:

- Torrens University Diploma of Business (HE)
- Torrens University Diploma of Business-Hospitality Management (HE)
- Think Education Diploma of Remedial Massage (VET)
- Torrens University Language Centre English Courses

You can also apply to any Torrens University & Think Education courses.

Will I get credits/RPL for the subjects I've already completed at Harvest Education Technical College?

Yes. Our academic team is reviewing HETC's course structure and we will be able to offer student credits for subjects previously studied at HETC's if they continue with the Torrens University Australia or Think Education equivalent course.

What campuses am I eligible to study at?

We have campuses in Adelaide, Melbourne, Sydney and Brisbane. Torrens University offers courses online as well as on campus.

Can I study online?

Yes – some programs are available to be studied online. Please note onshore international students who are on a student visa can study up to 33% online only.

I am currently on an international student visa. What are the implications for me?

As soon as you confirm your enrolment with us, the Department of Education and the Department of Home Affairs will be informed of your transfer to Torrens University when your new Confirmation of Enrolment is issued. If you are currently in a Vocational student visa, we suggest discussing with your agent.

How will this change affect my Confirmation of Enrolment (COE)?

If you agree to transfer to Torrens University, your HETC CoE will be cancelled and you will be issued with a new Coe to study with Torrens University.

How do I go about applying to enroll at Torrens University?

International Students: Please fill out an international student application form and a credit transfer request form (undergraduate). You can do this in person today or at a later date.

When can I enroll?

Our next intake (Trimester 1) commences on 25th February 2019.
