**Credit for Recognised Learning (CRL)**

CRL is when you receive credit for previous study that you have done. Curtin grants credit for units within your course. To assess the amount of CRL from your studies at the Australian School of Management you will need to provide your transcript so we can confirm the units you have completed and what credit we can then grant for your chosen course.

**Bachelor of Business Administration**

The Bachelor of Business Administration combines this broad subject with the opportunity to study and learn in a global environment. You will complete eight core units in the first two semesters and a mix of core and elective units in your second and third years. As part of this course you will take part in a competition to run the most successful virtual company and have the opportunity to participate in industry-based projects and international study tours.

**Bachelor of Commerce**

The Bachelor of Commerce with is an internationally recognised business qualification and is designed to help you gain the theory and practical skills you need to be ready for the job market. A number of majors are available including Tourism and Hospitality. You may also gain work experience through work placements, vacation placements and internships.
