Course Location

Sydney Melbourne

CQU English programs are also available at the Brisbane and Rockhampton campuses For any students who are still located offshore all courses are available through online classes, with classes arranged to suit each group of students' timezone.

Please see Attachment 2 for full listing of courses, location and dates of availability.

General English courses are normally arranged to align with the University term intakes, however we are able to offer flexibility to the dates for students requiring this course depending upon their proficiency level. This will allow us to tailor the course and number of weeks to their needs.

Course Duration

Each course is offered in 10 week blocks allowing flexibility of placement for students who may be part way through their level. CQU English will provide a placement test for each student to determine the number of weeks that may be required to complete their level.

This will provide assistance for those students who require this to assess the number of weeks required for General English, or to confirm placement in EAP classes. This will allow us to tailor the number of weeks to the student need where possible.

Course Fees

2021 Tuition fees are \$310/week. There are no other fees charged to CQU English students as all materials and other costs are included in the weekly fee.

Should student wish to package to a degree or VET program with CQUniversity, those students would be eligible to receive their English course for no charge, however the package offer would be required to be issued as part of the application process. Students would also be eligible for all CQU scholarships for their degree courses if they chose to package their English with a CQU degree course.

Additional CQU Information and Terms

Package offers and reduced English tuition fees:

For students interested in package offers to CQU degree courses, CQU offers the opportunity to complete their English program at no charge. Students would need to apply for a package to the program, and accept that offer through the standard CQU acceptance and enrolment processes. Students will still be required to pay the standard onshore COE deposit of \$2,000

Reduced CoE deposit for onshore students:

Onshore students who require a new COE pay a reduced deposit as part of the acceptance process. In recognition of the circumstances for the students transferring from Ability English to a standalone CQU English course, CQU will reduce the COE deposit further for these students to \$1,000

Online classes:

For students who may have joined the Ability English program and are still located offshore, CQU offers all classes online allowing those students to join their classmates. Classes are scheduled according to student timezones to cater for the different groups of students.

CQU can set up information sessions for students at our Sydney and Melbourne campuses where they can also meet their teachers.

Scholarships:

Students who apply for a package with CQU (English plus an academic course) are eligible for CQU scholarships for the degree portion of their academic course. The scholarships are for the full course duration, and are for those students who commence their pathway in 2021.
