Structure

Students are required to complete a total of 24 units including eight core units, and eight units from one of the following majors. Students must also complete eight additional units as either an additional major or electives.

CB69 – Bachelor of Hospitality Management

This course is designed to provide degree level education to supplement an Australian Qualifications Framework (AQF) recognised Diploma in Hospitality Management. It provides students an opportunity to widen their career prospects in hospitality management by exposing them to studies in business related disciplines. Students complete 16 units which include 12 core units and four electives.

Academic credit processes

When students apply via CQUniversity's [online application form](#) their application will be automatically assessed for credit transfer. Students will need to provide a copy of all of their academic transcripts and any course outlines that they may have from previous studies.

CQUniversity will assess the units (subjects) students have completed. An offer will be sent to the student listing how many units of credit they are eligible for and the expected study duration.
